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Today's presentation will cover the Department of State's (DoS) upcoming EVOLVE Information Technology RFP.

The two recent DoS webinars have focused mainly on clarifying details for the Draft RFP, as well as changes to the planned request. A lot of the focus has been on the role of Small Businesses. Today's webinar will focus mainly on the Small Business aspect, and how to use Capture2Proposal's analytics to make smarter teaming and bid decisions.

DoS EVOLVE – Updates on the Functional Category Awards



The DoS EVOLVE IT Services Vehicle has caught a lot of attention – Since C2P's last webinar on Evolve, there have been a few changes to the planned awards and terminology:

- The five distinct award areas will be referred to as Functional Categories and *not* Pools going forward.
- More awards will be reserved for Small Businesses the new breakdown is on the next page.
- While the plan is to have 6-8 awards per functional area, there is a possibility more awards will be made. The
 proportion of awards for Small Businesses will not be lowered, though; any additional awards under full and open
 competition will also result in additional awards under the Small Business set aside for the same functional category,
 where one exists.
- As before, while it is possible to bid for awards in multiple pools, there will be limits to how many awards a single company can win:
 - Awardees for Functional Area 1 **cannot** receive awards in any other pool, nor can they partner or subcontract with vendors on any other pool.
 - Awardees in Functional Areas 2-5 are limited to a maximum of two awards as a prime contractor across the remaining four pools.
 - A prime contractor can also be a subcontractor in the same functional category.
 - Bidding in all categories is still allowed; decisions will be made by the government at award time.

DoS EVOLVE – Updates on the Functional Category Awards



More awards are now planned, with Small Business Awards in the first three functional categories. All Full & Open bids must also have a small business subcontracting plan included. The Department of State is looking more to the DoD rules for subcontracting in an effort to improve small business participation in their contracts.

- 3. Provide better, accessible tools and infrastructure for our diplomats and staff to do their jobs flexibly, efficiently, and securely, from Washington and from the field.

- Pool 1 awards are anticipated before the awards in the other four pools. An RFP is likely to be released in early September.
- Task orders should be released very soon after the awards are announced.
 - Review the current IRM IT contracts set to expire this year as their task orders will likely be recompeted through EVOLVE.



Keep your customer and their needs in mind! Per the EVOLVE Q&A:


Winning proposals will show insight by identifying the risks that really matter to DoS and proposing perceptive mitigations with proof of effectiveness. Insight requires that bidders know the DoS customers and their hot buttons. However, it also requires proven relevant experience. Based on experience, bidders must describe risks they have encountered facing similar technical challenges and how they mitigated them successfully. An insightful risk approach must also prioritize risks based on probability and show the impacts pre- and post-mitigation.
